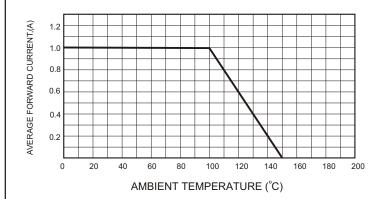

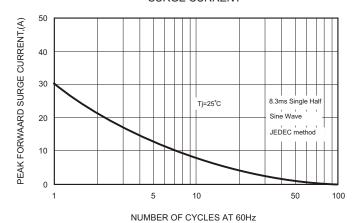

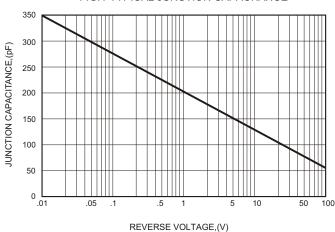
#### FIG.1-TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE



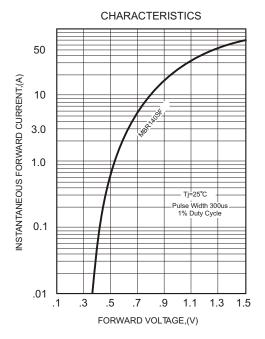
# FIG.3-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
